



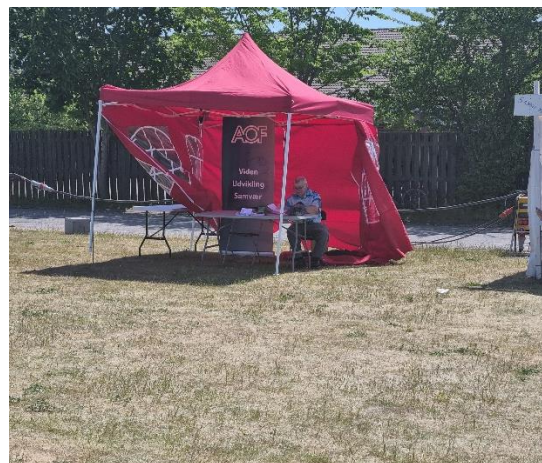
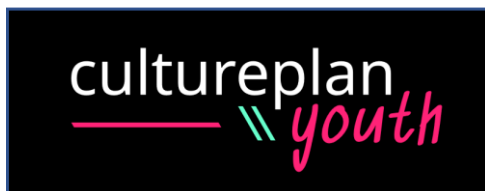
GREEN CULTURE FESTIVAL IN BRONDBY STRAND, DENMARK

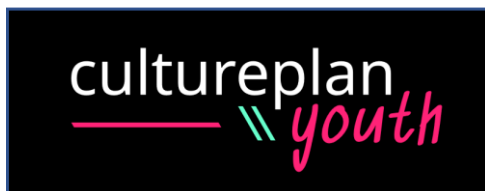
